Balanced Migration's response to today's announcement

Commenting on today's Migration Advisory Committee's report, Frank Field and Nicholas Soames said:

'Today's announcement shows the fundamental weakness of the Government's new system: there is still no limit on the number of people who are going to be given permission to settle in this country.

So, for all the Government's talk, without a limit its point based system is pretty pointless.

It's time we break the link between giving permission to come and work here, and giving permission to people to settle here permanently. That's why it's time for a policy of Balanced Migration'.
